Day 1:


The tenth QS Reimagine Education Conference commenced with 680 delegates from 62 countries meeting in Abu Dhabi, hosted by Khalifa University. The day's focus was on the future of learning environments, including AI and VR applications for personalized learning and career development. Issues challenging educators, entrepreneurs, and employers were discussed, and innovative projects from over 1,200 applicants were presented, with the announcement of awards winners anticipated later in the week.

Day 2:


Education and industry leaders elaborated on the importance of collaboration between universities and employers to bridge the skills gap. Strategies for aligning education with industry needs and providing practical experience were shared. Nadia El-Gowely emphasized the relevance of the skills gap due to rapid global changes and the need for seizing opportunities. Advice for universities to create successful partnerships included trust-building, managing expectations, focusing on students, diversifying partnerships, and clearly offering value to employers.

Day 3:


